### **Highlights from the Event Show floor**

**THE** 2016 Event Show drew to a close on Fri, with Meetings and Events (MEA) chief executive officer Linda Gaunt deeming the two-day show a success.

"There were two distinct comments that prove the success of the show," Gaunt told **Business Events News**. "Firstly, an exhibitor telling the team that they had received 40 qualified leads to follow up, and secondly a

visitor telling us that they now had so many new ideas and products to take back to the office and implement into the way they plan events."

Gaunt said the biggest improvement on this year's event was the attendance to their knowledge sessions, with the opening keynote from Google on Day One attracting 412 people who then walked straight onto the floor to meet with our exhibitors.
