The hotel offers a 500-seat restaurant and 24-hour cafe.



DONALD Trump's hotel interests were back in the news on the weekend, this time because of a fire in the Trump International Hotel and Tower in New York City.

A blaze on the 47th floor forced a partial evacuation of the building shortly before dawn on Fri, and although one person was treated for smoke inhalation there were no serious injuries reported.

Fire crews extinguished the fire within an hour and believe the cause to have been faulty machinery in one of the tower's apartments.

The property overlooks Central Park from its prime location at Columbus Circle. In the spirit of its owner, the hotel claims to offer "the best" conference and meetings facilities in New York City.
