# **HK MICE arrivals uptick**

**OVERNIGHT** MICE arrivals to Hong Kong from Australia, New Zealand and South Pacific have jumped 9.8% to 24,725 between Jan and Jun, compared to the prior corresponding period.

Of the other long-haul markets, MICE visitors from Europe, Africa and the Middle East to Hong Kong totalled 89,025 (+10.7%), followed by delegates from the Americas at 65,414 (+7.9%).

Hong Kong Tourism Board regional director Andrew Clark said he is "pleased with the positive growth in the sector and says conferences, in particular, are experiencing solid figures.

"Event organisers are becoming more aware of Hong Kong as a
